October is National Breast Cancer Awareness Month and more than the color for breast cancer awareness, pink represents a promise to find a cure for breast cancer. That promise has ignited the passion of millions to create a world without breast cancer. The promise encourages companies, schools and organizations to make a difference by supporting breast cancer research, education, screening and treatment.

Pink Ribbon Softball, Inc. proudly announces the **21st Annual PINK Breast Cancer Awareness Tournament**. In its inaugural year (2006), the tournament raised **\$8,795** for **Susan G. Komen** and the **Princeton's YWCA Breast Cancer Resource Center**, and in 2007 exceeded the tournament goal by donating **\$24,200** to the charities. Not to be outdone, the 64 participating 2008 tournament teams raised and donated **\$40,000** to the breast cancer charities. The 2009 tournament saw the entry field climb to 72 teams, who, despite the recession were able to raise and donate over **\$42,000**. Encouraged by the previous year's donation total, the 2010 tournament numbered 78 teams who amassed **\$60,000** in donations to the charities. Continuing the tradition, the 82 teams entered in the 2011 tournament combined to present the tournament charities with **\$50,000**. The 2012 event also fielded 82 teams who endeavored to best the previous event's gift to the charities with a tournament donation of **\$60,000**. The 2013 entry field rose to 86 participating teams who destroyed all previous tournament records with an **\$85,000** donation to the charities. The 2014 event fielded 96 teams who demolished the previous years with a **\$92,000** contribution to the charities. 2015's event showcased 86 teams that presented the tournament beneficiaries with an amazing **\$82,000** donation. The 2016 tournament had 84 teams united in Playing for the **PINK** to donate **\$85,000** to the charities. In 2017, the **PINK** Tournament shattered all previous event records with 91 teams raising and donating **\$100,000** to our beneficiaries! 2018's event was a complete rain out, but 82 wonderful teams still battled against breast cancer without a tournament by raising and donating **\$75,000**. The 2019 **PINK** Tournament fielded 74 teams who battled each other on the field but joined together off the field to raise and donate **\$70,000** to our grateful charities. The 2020 68 team tournament field elevated their game amid a pandemic and gifted our beneficiaries with a **\$77,000** donation. A 61 team field stepped up their game and set a new team donation average record with their **\$82,000** total gift to the 2021 **PINK** Tournament charities. **PINK** teams on field for the 2022 event blasted one out of the park with a record setting **\$110,000** charity donation. 2023's 84 teams played great softball while dodging rain and pitched in to raise the second highest donation to date of **\$106,000**. 2024 saw **PINK** welcome **Unite for HER** to our beneficiary roster and 67 teams worked hard and played even harder to donate **\$90,000** total gift to the three charities. In a powerful display of heart and hustle, our 77 teams—supported by our incredible sponsors and volunteers—knocked it out of the park with a massive **\$100,500** donation for 2025! This brings our all-time total to an astounding \$1,439,495 raised in the fight against breast cancer.

The 2025 tournament fundraising goal is to **exceed \$50,000** and we ask that you, your team and your team's families join in helping to reach that goal.

HOW CAN TEAMS HELP?

PINK is a **fundraising** softball tournament in which the participating teams fundraise for the tournament donation to local community breast cancer charities. Each team manager is asked to present to their team the idea of helping to support the cause, background information regarding breast cancer awareness and to teach their team the importance of community support and involvement.

Participating teams are asked to fundraise additional donations beyond the minimum \$275 tournament donation entry fee and bring their team donation on game day. Tournament entry fee is intentionally kept low due to the fundraising requirement of the event. Contest prizes will be awarded to the **Top Fundraising Team** and the **Top Fundraising Player** in each age group. These age groups must sanction with USSSA. The **PINK Tournament** will be run in the same fashion as it always has been and is a non-qualifying event. **PINK Tournament** division playing rules supersede USSSA rules.
